# Physical/Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, & 11

**Important:** On 6/13/19, NYS eliminated the religious exemption from vaccinations for school attendance. Information is available on the NYS Department of Health website.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations.

Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, & 11

Immunization	Number of Doses	
DTaP/DTP	3 to 5 doses	
Tdap	Grade 6 and Age 11: Must receive an immunization containing Tetanus Toxoids, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (Tdap) WITHIN 14 days of 11 <sup>th</sup> birthday, Minimum age 10 years old	
Polio	4 doses or 3 doses if the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was received at age 4 or older	
MMR	2 doses	
Hepatitis B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B Vaccine (Recombivax) for children who received doses at least 4 months apart between ages 11 through 15 years	
Varicella (chickenpox)	2 doses	
Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)	Grade 7: 1 dose- Minimum age 10 years old Grade 7 or 8*, 9*, & 10*	
MEDICAL EXEMPTIONS	UPDATED ANNUALLY within the first 14 days of school	
PHYSICAL EXAM REQUIREMENT DUE BY October 31st	GRADES <mark>7, 9, and 11</mark> . Annually if playing a school sport.	

<sup>\*</sup> Most of the students in grade 8, 9, and 10 will have already received the MENACWY vaccine dose in grade 7, unless transferred from out of state or out of country. MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 11.

### • EXCLUSION DATE is 14 days from the 1st day of school
